### NEW JUDGE

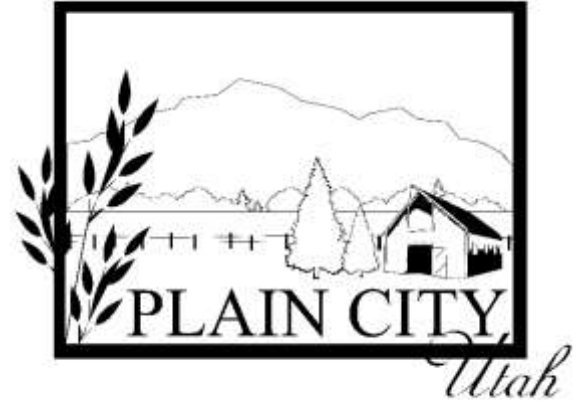
Plain City Justice Court welcomes Bryan Memmott as the new Justice Court Judge.

## **NEW DEPARTMENT BUILDING**

The Department of Public Works has recently opened, October of 2017, its new 7200 sq.ft. facility at 4181 W 2410 N - a building designed to target fit and function.

The main structure includes open bays for vehicle and large equipment storage with overhead doors, offices for the Director and Assistant Director of Public Works, and an office for the Director of Parks and Recreation. The new site also houses a break room, restrooms, storage areas, and a sewer equipment shop.

On the grounds, there is an advanced truck washing bay and additional covered storage for vehicles and machinery. These improvements will help preserve the condition of Public Works implements.

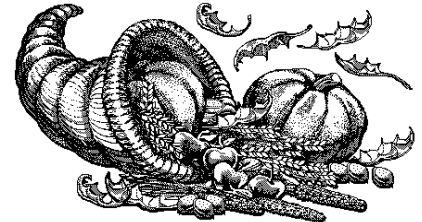
