The Plain City Landfill, located approximately at 2700 N 5100 W, will be open to dumping every 2nd and 4th Saturday of the months December through March, between the hours of 8 am and 3 pm.

Snow Removal

THANK YOU, citizens of Plain City, for making snow removal less burdensome this season.

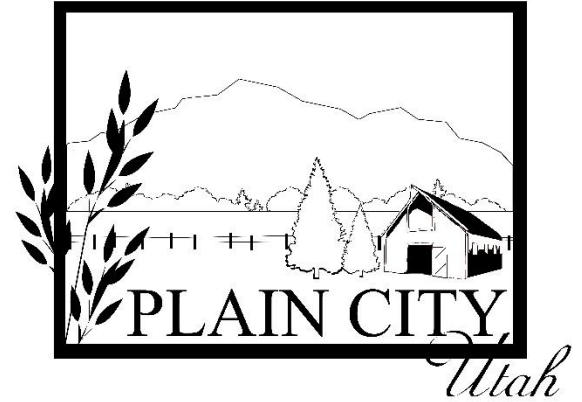
Please continue to park vehicles off the streets when the snowplows are operating throughout the city (up to 48 hours after a snowstorm), and remove emptied waste cans from the curb as quickly as possible. Parking on the street is prohibited between the hours of 1:00am and 7:00am, Nov. 1 – April 1.

Remember- snow removed from drives and walks should be pushed onto areas of property that do not extend into the street or path of city snowplows (official code can be found on the Plain City website @ plaincityutah.org).

City-scheduled snow removal doesn't always coincide with the schedules of our citizens but will be thoughtfully executed with the intent to serve the whole community well.

Public Works Message

As Plain City is geographically situated on a plain, the sewer system must go through several lift (pump) stations before terminating at the sewer lagoons. We have experienced problems with blockages in some area lift stations. Cleaning cloths, even "disposable" ones, and other non-flushable objects have been caught in the pumps, resulting in some costly repairs. Please do not flush anything other than toilet paper. Sewer pump jams can cause backups into homes. The Public Works Department would appreciate your cooperation, so that won't happen.

Storm Water

Measures taken to remove flood water from your property must not cause harm to others. It is illegal for sump pumps to discharge into the public sewer system. If you are not sure that your sump pump is set up correctly, please call the Plain City offices for assistance.

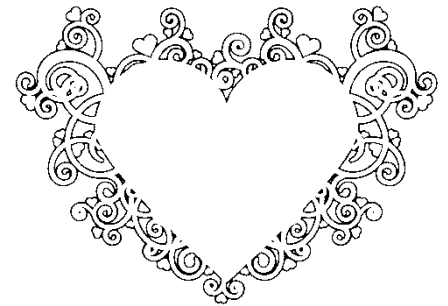

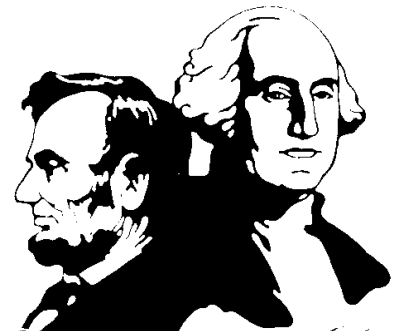
