

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-06

**A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE DESIRE OF PLAIN CITY  
TO SPECIFY THE TYPES OF TREES  
ALLOWED IN PARK STRIPS**

WHEREAS, the City of Plain City (herein “City”) is a municipal corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Utah; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that in conformance with the provisions of UCA §10-3-717, the governing body of the city may exercise all administrative powers by resolutions; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that there is good cause for specifying the types of trees allowed in the city parks and also park strips; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Plain City has established a City Tree Board (City Code Section 2-5-1 thru 2-5-5); and,

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved that in order to protect the curb and gutter as much as possible, and due to the average size of park strips (4 ft 6 in) throughout the city, understory type trees are only allowed.

THEREFORE, Be it Resolved that a no-fee permit (compliance permit) is required prior to the planning of the trees. This permit can be obtained in the Public Works Department.

THEREFORE, Be it Further Resolved that the City Council of Plain City, Utah, designate the following list of trees allowed in the park strips: **(Please see Exhibit A for descriptions and pictures)**

Aristocrat Pear  
Bechtel Crabapple  
Bradford Pear  
Capital Pear  
Carriere Hawthorn  
Chanticleer Pear  
Eastern Redbud  
English Hawthorn  
Flowering Plum  
Golden-rain Tree  
Japanese Tree Lilac  
Kwanzan Cherry  
Queen Elizabeth Hedge Maple

Serviceberry (tree form)  
Spring Snow Crabapple  
Washington Hawthorn
